**THE RECORDS**: Today marks the 2017 Ohio Athletic Conference opener for both schools. Marietta is currently 1-0 after posting a 26-25 comefrom-behind victory on the road at Geneva two weeks ago. Mount Union is 1-0 after defeating N.C. Wesleyan 58-0 in its season opener at home two weeks ago.

**THE COACHES**: Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is in his fifth season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including the last seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made trips to the NCAA tournament during Waddle's time at Wittenberg.

Mount Union is coached by **Vince Kehres**, who is in his fifth season at the helm of the Purple Raider football program and has a career record of 56-4 at Mount Union. Kehres, a 1998 graduate of Mount Union, spent 13 seasons on the Purple Raider coaching staff including the last eight as defensive coordinator before taking over for his father, Larry Kehres. As either a player or a coach, Kehres has been a part of 11 of Mount Union's 12 national championships.

**ALL-TIME SERIES**: Saturday marks the 56th time that the two teams will meet on the gridiron. **Mt. Union currently leads the series**, **46-8-1**. The series began in 1933 with Mount Union winning 20-0. The Purple Raiders have won 37 straight against the Pioneers dating back to 1980. Marietta's last victory over Mount Union was a 20-6 decision in 1977.

**LAST MEETING**: It was all Mount Union from start to finish as the Purple Raiders raced out to a 50-0 halftime lead en route to a 56-0 victory in Mount Union Stadium. **Tanner Clark** was Marietta's leading rusher with 48 yards on 10 carries. **Darrien Fields** completed 14-of-31 passes for 156

yards. He was picked off twice. **Ray Racine** caught 2 passes for 61 yards and **Alex Smith** had 3 catches for 39 yards. **Cody Walker** led the Pioneer defense with 12 tackles. **BJ Mitchell** led the Purple Raiders ground attack with 6 carries for 120 yards and 3 touchdowns. **Luke Poorman** completed all 7 passes he attempted for 121 yards and 1 TD. **D'Angelo Fulford** completed 4-of-5 passes for 37 yards and a pair of TDs. **Jordan Hargrove** caught 3 passes for 96 yards and 1 TD, while **Jared Ruth** had 3 catches for 7 yards and 2 TDs. **Danny Robinson** recorded 6 tackles to lead the Mount Union defense.

#### THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 30 letter winners and 17 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 9 starters on offense, 6 on defense and 2 on special teams. The Pioneers are currently ranked 9th in the OAC in total offense (374.0 ypg) and is 5th in total defense (316.0 ypg). Sophomore running back Tanner Clark is Marietta's leading rusher with 77 yards on 16 carries. Senior Roger Walker has 63 yards on 15 carries and 1 TD. Junior quarterback Darrien Fields has completed 22-of-30 passes for 171 yards and 3 TDs. Senior Alex Smith and sophomore Andrew Barker are MC's leading receivers. Smith has 6 receptions for 48 yards and 1 TD, while Barker has caught 5 passes for 60 yards and 1 TD. Senior linebacker Nick O'Neal leads the defense with 11 tackles.

Mount Union returns 52 lettermen and 17 starters off of last year's NCAA Tournament roster. The Purple Raiders return 6 starters on offense, 8 on defense and 3 on special teams. Currently, the Purple Raiders are ranked 4th in the OAC in total offense (449.0 ypg) and 1st in total defense (149.0 ypg). Sophomore quarterback **D'Angelo Fulford** has completed 16-of-21 passes for 213 yards and 3 TDs. Sophomore wide receiver **Justin Hill** has 5 receptions for 92 yards and 3 TDs. Fulford is also Mount Union's leading rusher with 78 yards on 7 carries. Junior running back **Jawanza Evans-Morris** has 49 yards on 7 carries as well. Defensively, senior defensive back **Kason Hooks**, senior linebacker **Charlie Dear** and junior defensive back **Austin White** all have 5 tackles to lead the Purple Raiders.

**92ND SEASON OF OAC PLAY**: 2017 marks Marietta College's 92nd season of Ohio Athletic Conference football. The Pioneers, who joined the league in 1926, are 181-367-11 (.334) all-time in OAC play. Marietta's lone OAC championship came in 1936 when the Pioneers went 4-0 in league play.

**THIS WEEK IN THE OAC**: All 10 OAC schools are in action this week with four afternoon games and one under the lights. There are two games starting at 1:30 p.m. including Mount Union at Marietta and Heidelberg at Ohio Northern. Two games will kickoff at 2 p.m. including Otterbein hosting Wilmington and John Carroll traveling to crosstown rival Baldwin Wallace. The lone night game features Muskingum at Capital.

CAPTAINS ANNOUNCED: Marietta College will have three captains during the 2017 season. Senior running back Roger Walker (Palm Bay, Fla. / Bayside), senior offensive lineman Anthony Jalowiec (Grafton, Ohio / Midview) and junior linebacker Garrett Davis (Marietta, Ohio / Marietta). Walker, a three-year letterman, returns as team captain after earning first team All-OAC and honorable mention All-American honors last season. He averaged 129.2 yards per game rushing and scored a team-best 16 touch-downs. Jalowiec, a three-year letterman, started the first seven games of the season last year before an injury sidelined him for the remainder of the season. The Pioneer offensive line helped Walker lead the OAC in rushing during the regular season. Davis earned his first varsity letter after leading the Pioneers in tackles last fall with 90 total stops. He made 41 solo tackles and assisted on 49 others.

**NATIONAL REPRESENTATION**: Marietta's roster currently features 100 total student-athletes on the roster representing 10 states — 58 from Ohio, 20 from Pennsylvania, eight from West Virginia, five from Texas, three from Florida, two each from Illinois and North Carolina and 1 each from Georgia, Maryland and South Carolina.

**MID-OHIO VALLEY ALUMNI DAY**: Mid-Ohio Valley Alumni Day at Don Drumm Stadium will be held September 23rd when the Pioneers host rival Muskingum University at 1:30 p.m. The game will also feature the battle for the Shrine Trophy and proceeds from the game go to the local Shrine Club.

**HOMECOMING**: Marietta College Homecoming is set for the weekend of October 20-22. The Pioneers will meet Heidelberg University on Saturday. Kickoff is set for 1:30 p.m.

**VETERANS APPRECIATION DAY**: Marietta College will honor members of the five branches of the military, both past and present, on November 11th when Otterbein University visits Don Drumm Stadium for a 1:30 p.m. kickoff. All veterans and enlisted personnel will receive free admission and will be recognized on the field at halftime. The Pioneers will also honor the senior members of the football team and cheerleading squad prior to the game.
