THE RECORDS: Saturday marks the fifth week of Ohio Athletic Conference play. Marietta is currently 2-3 overall and 1-3 in the OAC after falling to John Carroll 48-21 in Don Drumm Stadium. Wilmington comes in with a 2-3 overall record and 1-3 record in the OAC after losing at Baldwin Wallace 38-21 last week.

THE COACHES: Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is in his fourth season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including the last seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made trips to the NCAA tournament during Waddle's time at Wittenberg.

Wilmington's **Bryan Moore** is in his 1st season as the head coach of the Quaker football program. Moore, a graduate of Hiram College, came to Wilmington from Bluffton College where he served as the offensive coordinator for three seasons under head coach Denny Dorrel, a former Marietta College assistant. Prior to his time at Bluffton, Moore served as the offensive coordinator at Heidelberg and Emory & Henry. He began his coaching career as an assistant at Thomas More.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday marks the 27th time that the two teams will meet on the gridiron. **Marietta currently leads the series**, **16-10**. The series began in 1915 with the Pioneers winning 68-7. The two schools have played every year since 2000. The Pioneers have won eight of the last 10 meetings and 12 of the 17 games since the series restarted in 2000 after a 45-year hiatus. Marietta has won the last four meetings, with the Quakers' last win coming in 2012 by the score of 13-12 in Wilmington.

LAST MEETING: Marietta jumped out to a 37-0 first quarter lead, went into halftime ahead 60-20, and won the game 66-23. The Pioneers scored points five different ways in the game as the offense, defense and spe-

cial teams all put points on the board. Marietta finished with 575 yards of total offense as **Roger Walker** rushed for 170 yards and 2 touchdowns on 17 carries. **Darrien Fields** completed 17-of-23 for 297 yards and 5 touchdowns. **Andrew Barker** caught 5 passes for 111 yards and 1 TD. Defensively, **Garrett Davis** had a team-high 13 tackles, while **Jakkar Bishop** blocked 2 kicks and returned one of them for a defensive PAT. Quarterback **Luke Creditt** led Wilmington with 49 rushing yards and 2 touchdowns on 12 carries. Running back **Eric Flynn** finished with 35 yards on 12 carries. Creditt completed 20-of-29 passes for 229 yards and 1 TD. He was picked off 4 times. **PJ Meyer** caught 8 passes for 155 yards and 1 touchdown. Defensively, **Mason Poland** lead the Quakers with 9 tackles.

THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 30 letter winners and 17 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 9 starters on offense, 6 on defense and 2 on special teams. The Pioneers are currently ranked 10th in the OAC in total offense (347.0 ypg) and is 10th in total defense (455.4 ypg). Senior running back Roger Walker is Marietta's leading rusher averaging 83.6 yards on 74 carries. He has 3 TDs. Junior Darrien Fields has completed 92-of-131 passes for 944 yards and 11 TDs. He has been picked off 4 times. Sophomore wide receiver Ryan Van Meter has 25 receptions for 220 yards, while classmate Andrew Barker has 17 receptions for 240 yards and 4 TDs. Linebacker Garrett Davis and defensive back Eric Klopfenstein are Marietta's leading tacklers. Davis, a junior outside backer, has 48 tackles, while Klopfenstein, a sophomore, has 34.

Wilmington returns 48 lettermen and 14 starters off of last year's roster. The Quakers are ranked 8th in the OAC in total offense (398.0 ypg) and 8th in total defense (450.8 ypg). Wilmington's ground game is lead by senior running Eric Flynn. Flynn averages 68.6 ypg on 62 carries. He has 4 touchdowns. Senior quarterback Luke Creditt is also a running threat averaging 56.2 ypg on 67 carries this season. Creditt has completed 66-of-109 passes for 977 yards and 12 touchdowns. He has been picked off 5 times. Senior wide receiver PJ Meyer has 16 catches for 374 yards and 5 touchdowns. Freshman wide receiver Ameer Jackson has 13 receptions for 176 yards and 1 score, while sophomore wide receiver AJ Hightower has 9 catches for 112 yards and 3 TDs. Freshman safety Leroy Wilson leads Wilmington with 38 tackles. Sophomore linebacker Bryan Gonzalez is close behind with 37 stops. Senior defensive tackle David Henry has 28 tackles including 5.5 for a loss.

weeks ago, a 60-yard gain, senior running back **Roger Walker** went over the 3000-yard mark for his career. He currently stands at 3038 yards entering today's game. Walker ran for 551 yards as a freshman in 2013; 752 yards in 2015 and 1292 yards last season.

SCORING MACHINE: Senior running back **Roger Walker** scored a pair of touchdowns last week against John Carroll giving him 37 for his career and moving him past Dallas Garber (1958-60) into third place on Marietta's all-time list. Dante Brown holds the Pioneer record with 54 and Kenneth Sasu is second with 43.

92ND SEASON OF OAC PLAY: 2017 marks Marietta College's 92nd season of Ohio Athletic Conference football. The Pioneers, who joined the league in 1926, are 182-370-11 (.333) all-time in OAC play. Marietta's lone OAC championship came in 1936 when the Pioneers went 4-0 in league play.

NEXT GAME: The Pioneers host Heidelberg University for Homecoming next weekend. Kickoff at Don Drumm Stadium is set for 1:30 p.m. Wilmington hosts nationally ranked Mount Union for a 1:30 p.m. kickoff in Williams Stadium.
