## FACILITIES

Marietta Soccer Camps will be held primarily on Marietta Field, the college team's game field. Located on the south end of campus, and completed prior to the 2005 fall season, the soccer field has a natural grass playing surface with a state-of-the-art drainage system. It measures 115 yards x 72 yards. We will be able to take advantage of the multiple portable goals that we use in the College program.



## ATHLETIC TRAINING STAFF

An athletic trainer will be on staff. Participants will not be covered with medical or dental insurance during the camp. (Marietta Soccer Camps, LLC or Marietta College is not responsible for any injuries sustained by a participant or camp employee.)



## MARCH 12-15 — SPRING BREAK CAMP

### Boys and Girls – Ages 6-14

Campers should plan on arriving at the field between 12:45 and 12:55 p.m. as camp will begin at 1:00 p.m. Camp will conclude each day at 4:00 p.m. and parents should plan on picking up their children at that time. Campers will be divided into their age and skill appropriate groups the first day of camp and work with that counselor the rest of the week. Camp cost is \$100 per child or \$90 per child if you are registering two or more children.

Equipment Needs for the camp are: comfortable cleats, shin-guards, a ball (with your child's name written on it), water bottle and sunscreen. Water is provided.

## JUNE 17-20 — GOALKEEPER CAMP

### Boys and Girls – Ages 6-17

Campers should plan on arriving at the field between 5:15 and 5:25 p.m. as camp will begin at 5:30 p.m. Camp will conclude each day at 7:30 p.m. and parents should plan on picking up their children at that time. Campers will be divided into their skill appropriate group the first day of camp and work with that counselor the rest of the week. Camp cost is \$100 per child or \$90 per child if you are registering two or more children. Space is limited so register early!

Equipment Needs for the camp are: comfortable cleats, goalkeeper gloves, shin-guards, a ball (with your child's name written on it), water bottle and sunscreen. Water is provided.

## JUNE 18-21 — DAY CAMP

### Boys and Girls – Ages 6-14

Campers should plan on arriving at the field between 8:45 and 8:55 a.m. as camp will begin at 9:00 a.m. Camp will conclude each day at noon and parents should plan on picking up their children at that time. Campers will be divided into their age and skill appropriate groups the first day of camp and work with that counselor the rest of the week. Camp cost is \$100 per child or \$90 per child if you are registering two or more children.

Equipment Needs for the camp are: comfortable cleats, shin-guards, a ball (with your child's name written on it), water bottle and sunscreen. Water is provided.



## APPLICATION & REGISTRATION

Complete and return the application form to enroll in the Marietta Soccer Camps LLC. Enrollment is limited to ensure quality individual instruction, so early registration is encouraged. After receiving your application and deposit, a confirmation email letter will be sent to you with additional camp information. Cancellation Policy: If cancellation of your registration is necessary, you will receive 100% of the cost of registration in return if we are notified 2 weeks before the start date of camp. If cancellation occurs with less than 2 weeks notification, you will receive a 50% refund for the cost of registration.
