THE RECORDS: Saturday marks week eight of OAC play. The Pioneers lost on the road to the Baldwin Wallace Yellow Jackets last week by the score of 66-14, while the Cardinals were victorious on the road at Capital by the score of 23-9. Marietta is currently 0-8 overall and 0-7 in the OAC. Otterbein is 6-2 overall and 5-2 in league play.

THE COACHES:

Marietta's **Jeff Filkovski** is 10-38 in his fifth season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the former signal caller for the Cologne Centurions of NFL Europe. Filkovski, who earned his bachelor's degree from Allegheny College in 1991, led the Gators to a national championship in 1990. He won OAC Assistant Coach of the Year honors as the offensive coordinator at Heidelberg in 2007.

Otterbein's **Tim Doup** is in his 1st season at the helm of the Cardinal football program. Doup, a '92 Otterbein graduate, is currently 6-2 at his alma mater. He spent nine seasons as the offensive coordinator with the Cardinals before taking over as head coach. Doup was a four-year letter winner at center for the Cardinals. He served as team captain his senior year.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday marks the 85th time that the two teams will meet on the gridiron. The series is currently even, 42-42-0, between the two schools. The series began in 1892 with the Pioneers winning 6-0. The two schools have played every year since 1950. The Cardinals have won seven of the last 10 meetings with the two schools alternating swins the past four seasons.

LAST MEETING: The Pioneers hit a field goal with two seconds left in the game to give Marietta a 30-27 victory in Westerville last year. Marietta jumped out to a 13-0 lead in the first quarter returning an interception for a TD and hitting a pair of field goals. Otterbein tied the game, 27-27, with 1:22 left in the fourth quarter. On the ensuing drive, quarterback **Andrew Keller** hit **Chad Walker** for a 23-yard gain on a 4th-and-16 to set up the game winning 38-yard field goal by **Jesse Shore**. Keller completed 24-of-40 passes for 330 yards and a TD. **Tannon Roberts** caught five passes for 136 yards and **Kirby Harris** had nine catches for 79 yards, while Walker ended the day with seven receptions for 84 yards. Otterbein's **Austin Schlosser** completed 18-of-32 passes for

199 yards and four TDs. He was picked off five times. **Cody Green** carried the ball 24 times for 153 yards rushing.

THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 31 letter winners and 15 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back six starters on offense, eight on defense and one on special teams. The Pioneers are currently ranked 8th in the OAC in total offense (259.5 ypg) and 10th in defense (445.9 ypg). Senior quarterback **Tom Fulton** has completed 141-of-297 passes for 1766 yards with 13 touchdowns and 12 interceptions. Senior running back **Tevin Dones** is the leading rusher with 238 net yards on 70 carries. The junior wide receiver tandem of **Kirby Harris** and **Tannon Roberts** are Marietta's leading receivers. Harris has 43 catches for 637 yards and six TDs, while Roberts has pulled in 34 aerials for 513 yards and two TDs. Defensively, junior linebacker **Jake Hammer** leads the team and the OAC with 87 tackles, including 33 solo stops. Junior linebacker **Franklin Holmes** and freshman linebacker **Joe Ortega** each have 43 tackles, while junior defensive back **Robert Brown** has a team-high two interceptions on the year.

Otterbein returns 44 lettermen and 13 starters off of last year's roster. The Cardinals return six starters on offense, six on defense and one on special teams. The Cardinals are currently ranked 7th in the OAC in offense (264.2 ypg) and 3rd in defense (295.6 ypg). Junior quarterback **Ben Sizemore**, who took over the starting duties in week seven, has completed 34-of-73 passes for 400 yards and three touchdowns with three interceptions. Junior **Steven Carpenter** and senior **Chris Irwin** lead the wide receiving corps. Carpenter has 27 catches for 404 yards and two TDs. Irwin has caught 20 passes for 196 yards. Senior **Trey Fairchild** has 19 receptions for 274 yards and three TDs. Senior running back **Brock Burzanko** is the Cardinals leading rusher with 225 yards on 92 carries. Junior defensive end **Zack Grieves** leads the team in tackles with 49. Senior cornerback **Anthony Korpieski** is among the OAC leaders with four interceptions on the season.

KEY MATCH-UP: The key match-up this week centers around the passing game. Marietta is ranked 4th in the OAC in passing offense averaging 224.8 yards per game, while Otterbein's passing defense is ranked 3rd in the OAC allowing 189.5 yards per game. The Cardinals have intercepted 15 opponent passes, second-best in the OAC. Marietta features four receivers with double digit receptions for the Cardinals to cover.

NATIONAL LEADERS: The Pioneers are ranked 1st in the nation in punt returns averaging 22.3 yards per return. Individually, linebacker **Jake Hammer** is ranked 25th in the nation and 1st in the OAC in tackles with 10.9 per game.

NEXT GAME: The Pioneers finish the 2012 season at home against their rival Muskingum University. The Pioneers host the Muskies in a 1:30 p.m. kick-off. The Cardinals host the Polar Bears of Ohio Northern University in a 1:30 p.m. battle.

THIS WEEK IN THE OAC: All 10 OAC schools play league games this week. All five games are slated for 1:30 p.m. kick-offs. Capital plays at Muskingum, John Carroll is at Heidelberg, Mount Union travels to Baldwin Wallace, Marietta hosts Otterbein and Wilmington plays at Ohio Northern.

87TH SEASON OF OAC PLAY: 2012 marks Marietta College's 87th season of Ohio Athletic Conference football. The Pioneers, who joined the league in 1926, are 174-336-11 (.345) all-time in OAC play.

CAPTAINS ANNOUNCED: Marietta College will have two captains during the 2012 season: senior linebacker Kadeem Corbin (Cheltenham, Md./Fredrick Douglas) and junior wide receiver Kirby Harris (Greenville, S.C./South Side). Corbin is a three-year letter winner and a two-year starter on defense. Harris, a two-year letterman, has played in 19 straight games and was the Pioneers' leading receiver last season with 61 receptions for 840 yards and six TD's.

AFCA TOP 25: The OAC has three teams ranked in the American Football Coaches Association Top 25: #1 Mount Union, #15 Baldwin Wallace and #17 Heidelberg. Mount Union collected 41 of 42 first place votes.

D3FOOTBALL.COM TOP 25: The OAC has three teams ranked in the d3football.com Top 25 this week: #1 Mount Union, #18 Heidelberg and #23 Baldwin Wallace. Mount Union collected 24 of 25 first place votes.

DON DRUMM STADIUM PROJECT: One year ago, Marietta College dedicated the "new" Don Drumm Stadium at halftime of the season opening game against Thiel. The \$3.6 million project was started with the installation of the turf and all-weather track in 2004 and culminated with the renovation and construction of the state-of-the-art four-story building. The new home of Pioneer football has had a major impact on recruiting as Marietta welcomed 128 student-athletes to preseason camp, including 80 new faces.

BASEBALL RING PRESENTATION: The defending National Champion Marietta College baseball team will receive their championship rings at halftime of today's game. The Etta Express has won an NCAA-best six Division III baseball championships: 1981, 1983, 1986, 2006, 2011 and 2012. The Pioneers became the first school to win back-to-back titles since Rowan University (formerly Glassboro State) did it in 1978 and 1979.
