**THE RECORDS:** Saturday marks the 2015 Ohio Athletic Conference opener for both teams. Marietta is currently 0-1 after losing its non-conference game at Denison 41-14 two weeks ago in Granville. Otterbein dropped its season-opener at home to Buffalo State by the score of 29-0. Last season the Pioneers went 1-8 in the OAC, while the Cardinals finished 5-4.

**THE COACHES:** Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is entering his third season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including the last seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made trips to the NCAA tournament during Waddle's time at Wittenberg.

Otterbein is coached by **Tim Doup**, who is in his fourth season at the helm of the Cardinal football program and has a career record of 18-13 at Otterbein. Doup, a '92 Otterbein graduate, spent nine seasons as the offensive coordinator with the Cardinals before taking over as head coach. Doup was a four-year letter winner at center for the Cardinals. He served as team captain his senior year.

**ALL-TIME SERIES:** Saturday marks the 88th time that the two teams will meet on the gridiron. **Otterbein currently leads the series, 45-42.** The series began in 1892 with the Pioneers winning 6-0. The two schools have played every year since 1950. The Cardinals have won eight of the last 10 meetings including the last three in a row. Marietta's last win came in 2011 by the score of 30-27.

**LAST MEETING:** Otterbein's defense pitched a shutout as the Cardinals defeated Marietta 20-0 in Westerville last year in the OAC opener for both schools. **Brick Davis** got the Cardinals on the board early in the second quarter with a 16-yard TD run. Otterbein also scored on its first possession of the third quarter when Davis hit **Chad McCray** on a 3-yard TD pass for a 14-0 lead. A pair of **Alana Gaither** field goals in the fourth quarter accounted for the 20-0 final score. Davis finished 19-of-27 for 177 yards, one TD and no interceptions. **Nick O'Neal** was

Marietta's leading rusher with 63 yards on 13 carries. **Lucas Havens** got the start at quarterback and completed 17-of-30 passes for 143 yards. He was intercepted twice. Linebacker **Daryl DeWindt** led MC with 12 tackles including 1 sack. Fellow linebacker **Cody Rice** made 11 tackles. Otterbein's defense was led by linebacker **Austin Jones**, who had 10 tackles.

### THE TEAMS:

**Marietta** returns 31 letter winners and 16 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back six starters on offense, nine on defense and one on special teams. The Pioneers are currently ranked 7th in the OAC in total offense (362.0 ypg) and 9th in total defense (484.0 ypg). Senior quarterback **Lucas Havens** has completed 17-of-41 passes for 177 yards and a TD. He has been intercepted twice. Sophomore wide receiver **Clay Moorefield** has caught 10 passes for 91 yards and a TD. Sophomore running back **Nick O'Neal** leads the OAC with 154.0 rushing yards per game. He has scored one rushing TD. Senior middle linebacker **Daryl DeWindt** leads the defense with 9 tackles, including 3.0 for a loss.

**Otterbein** returns 44 lettermen and 13 starters off of last year's roster. The Cardinals return seven starters on offense, five on defense and one on special teams. Currently, the Cardinals are ranked 10th in the OAC in total offense (114.0 ypg) and 10th in total defense (501.0 ypg). Senior quarterback **Kevan Green** completed 9-of-14 passes for 76 yards in the season-opener. He was intercepted 3 times. Sophomore wide receivers **Julian Lowe** and **Logan Stepp** each caught 3 passes. Senior running back **Speedy Hammond** was Otterbein's leading rusher with 17 yards on 9 carries. Senior linebacker **Drew Ervin** led the Cardinals with 11 tackles.

**90TH SEASON OF OAC PLAY:** 2015 marks Marietta College's 90th season of Ohio Athletic Conference football. The Pioneers, who joined the league in 1926, are 176-354-11 (.335) all-time in OAC play. Marietta's lone OAC championship came in 1936 when the Pioneers went 4-0 in league play.

**NEXT GAME:** The Pioneers are back at home next week to host the No. 2 ranked University of Mount Union. It will be Youth Football Day at Don Drumm Stadium as Marietta and the Purple Raiders square off in a 1:30 p.m. showdown. Otterbein hosts Wilmington in a 2:00 p.m. match up.

**THIS WEEK IN THE OAC:** All 10 OAC schools open conference play this week with one game kicking off at 2:00 p.m., one at 6:00 p.m. and three at 7:00 p.m. The early game features John Carroll traveling to Heidelberg. The Pioneers host Otterbein at 6:00 p.m. The late games include Muskingum at Mount Union, Baldwin Wallace at Ohio Northern and Capital at Wilmington.

2015 season: senior linebacker Daryl DeWindt (Lilburn, Ga. / Meadowcreek), senior quarterback Lucas Havens (Granville Summit, Pa. / Troy Area) and senior defensive lineman Joe Ortega (Fresno, Texas / Hightower). Ortega is a three-year letterman and served as a team captain last season as well. DeWindt has earned two varsity letters and Havens has one. Both are first-time team captains. Ortega was third in the OAC with 7.5 sacks last year and finished with 74 total tackles. DeWindt led the Pioneers and finished second in the OAC with 96 tackles, while Havens completed 38-of-75 passes for 466 yards a year ago.

**D3FOOTBALL.COM TOP 25:** The OAC had two teams ranked in the d3football.com Top 25 this week: #2 Mount Union and #10 John Carroll. Mount Union received four of the 25 first place votes. Ohio Northern is receiving votes.

**NATIONAL REPRESENTATION:** Marietta's roster currently features 93 total student-athletes on the roster representing 10 states — 45 from Ohio, 23 from Pennsylvania, 13 from Texas, 4 from West Virginia, 2 from Georgia, 2 from Virginia and 1 each from California, Florida, Illinois and New York.

**MID-OHIO VALLEY ALUMNI DAY:** The Pioneers will welcome the College's Wood County (W.Va.) and Washington County (Ohio) Alumni to Don Drumm Stadium today for the home-opener against Otterbein. Members of the Long Blue Line from Parkersburg and surrounding areas will be special guests. The Parkersburg High School marching band will perform the National Anthem and a halftime show.

**YOUTH FOOTBALL DAY:** The Pioneers will welcome the area youth football players to Don Drumm Stadium on October 26th when Mount Union visits for a 1:30 p.m. kickoff. The annual Punt, Pass and Kick competition will be held in the morning and the winners will be honored at halftime.

**HOMECOMING:** Marietta College Homecoming is set for the weekend of October 16-18. The Pioneers will meet John Carroll University on Saturday. Kickoff is set for 1:30 p.m. The Pioneers will honor the 20th anniversary of the 1995 team that finished with an 8-1-1 record and was ranked in the Top-10 nationally.

**VETERANS APPRECIATION DAY:** Marietta College will honor members of the five branches of the military, both past and present, on November 7 when Muskingum University visits Don Drumm Stadium for a 1:30 p.m. kickoff. All veterans and enlisted personnel will receive free admission and will be recognized on the field at halftime.

**SHRINE TROPHY GAME:** Marietta and Muskingum will battle for the annual Shrine Trophy when the two schools meet at Don Drumm Stadium on November 7 for a 1:30 p.m. kickoff. The Pioneers will be looking to regain the trophy as Muskingum has won the annual contest the last six year.
