THE RECORDS: Saturday marks the first week of Ohio Athletic Conference play. Marietta is currently 1-0 overall after knocking off Geneva at home, 35-24, last week. Capital lost its season opener on the road at Mount St. Joseph last week by the score of 59-21.

THE COACHES: Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is in his sixth season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including the last seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made trips to the NCAA tournament during Waddle's time at Wittenberg.

Capital's **Chad Rogosheske** is in his third season as the head coach of the Crusader football program. Rogosheske, a 1998 graduate of Hamline University, is currently 15-36 in his coaching career having gone 10-20 in three years at the helm of Hamline and is 5-16 at Capital. Rogosheske spent time as an assistant at Bucknell, Hamline, Wartburg and Ohio State.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday marks the 88th time that Marietta and Capital will meet on the gridiron. Capital holds a 55-30-2 lead in the series. The first meeting took place in 1927 with Marietta winning 14-0. The two schools have faced each other annually since 1946. The Pioneers dominated the series early on winning seven of the first 10 meetings. In recent years, Capital has controlled the series winning the 13 of the last 15 meetings between the two schools. The Pioneers have won the last two meetings including a 27-21 win in Don Drumm two years ago and last year's 49-21 win in Columbus.

LAST MEETING: Marietta outscored Capital 14-0 in the first quarter and never looked back en route to a 49-21 win in Bernlohr Stadium. Marietta All-American running back **Roger Walker** scored three times including a 70-yard TD run that extended the Pioneer lead to 42-14. Walker finished

with 224 yards rushing on 29 carries. Quarterback **Darrien Fields** completed 17-of-26 passes for 169 yards and 2 TD's. Fields also rushed for 73 yards on 7 carries and scored 1 rushing TD. Capital quarterback **Thomas Wibbeler** threw for 279 yards on 24-of-46 passing attempts. He tossed 3 TD passes. **Dar Stanford** had 9 catches for 131 yards and 2 scores. Defensively, linebacker **Christopher Dowell** led the Pioneers with 9 tackles, while **Eric Stroski** had 12 tackles to lead Capital.

THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 31 letter winners and 17 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 8 starters on offense, 7 on defense and 2 on special teams. The Pioneers are currently ranked 5th in the OAC in total offense (385.0 ypg) and is 6th in total defense (346.0 ypg). Junior running back Tanner Clark is Marietta's leading rusher averaging 128.8 yards on 19 carries, second best in the OAC. He has 3 TDs. Senior Darrien Fields has completed 15-of-21 passes for 200 yards and 1 TD. Junior wide receiver Andrew Barker ranks fifth in the OAC with 4 receptions for 91 yards and 1 TD. Senior linebacker Garrett Davis is Marietta's leading tackler with 12 total stops. Sophomore linebacker Caleb Boy returned a fumble 53 yards for a TD last week.

Capital returns 52 lettermen and 13 starters off of last year's roster. The Crusaders return 6 starters on offense, 6 on defense and 1 on special teams. Capital is ranked 7th in the OAC in total offense (340.0 ypg) and 10th in total defense (605.0 ypg). Capital is led by senior quarterback Thomas Wibbeler, a second team All-OAC honoree last year. Wibbeler is the Crusaders' leading rusher with 79 yards on 14 carries. He has completed 19-of-35 passes for 201 yards and 3 TDs. Junior wide receiver David Barnett has 10 receptions for 100 yards and 2 TDs. Sophomore middle linebacker and senior defensive back Jake Lindsey lead the Capital defense with 6 tackles each.

NEXT GAME: The Pioneers hit the road for the annual Shrine Trophy Game at Muskingum next week. Kickoff is set for 1:30 p.m. in New Concord. Capital returns home to host Heidelberg in its home opener. Kickoff is slated for 7 p.m.

THIS WEEK IN THE OAC: It's a light week in the OAC with just three games on tap. Muskingum travels to Ohio Northern at 1:30 p.m., Marietta hosts Capital a 3:30 p.m. and Otterbein plays at Baldwin Wallace at 6 p.m.

CHASING HISTORY #1: With his 200 yards passing last week, senior quarterback **Darrien Fields** went over 4,000 yards passing for his career. He currently ranks 4th all-time at Marietta with 4,021 yards passing. Jason Vrable (2003-06), current assistant coach with the New York Jets, holds the all-time record at Marietta with 6,102 career yards.

CHASING HISTORY #2: With his 1 touchdown pass last week, **Fields** moved into a tie for 2nd place on Marietta's all-time list for career TD passes. Fields is currently tied with Andrew Keller (2008-11) with 35 career TD passes. Jason Vrable (2003-06) holds the all-time record at Marietta with 41 career TD passes.

CHASING HISTORY #3: With his 15 pass completions last week, **Fields** is closing in on 3rd place on Marietta's all-time list for career completions. Fields is currently 4th with 374 career completions. Shawn Taylor (1999-01) is third with 385 completions, Andrew Keller (2008-11) is 2nd with 484 and Jason Vrable (2003-06) is 1st with 495 career completions.

CAPTAINS ANNOUNCED: Marietta College will have a trio of senior captains during the 2018 season including quarterback **Darrien Fields** (Aliquippa, Pa. / Aliquippa), left tackle **Caleb Riggleman** (Beverly, W.Va. / Elkins) and linebacker **Garrett Davis** (Marietta, Ohio / Marietta).

NATIONAL REPRESENTATION: Marietta's roster currently features 110 total student-athletes representing 9 states — 68 from Ohio, 21 from Pennsylvania, 11 from West Virginia, 2 each from Arizona, Florida, Tennessee and Texas and 1 each from Virginia and Wisconsin.
