THE RECORDS: Saturday marks the fourth week of Ohio Athletic Conference play. Marietta is currently 3-0 overall and 2-0 in the OAC after beating Muskingum, 46-20, two weeks ago. After three straight home games to start the season, Ohio Northern went on the road last week and beat Otterbein, 13-7, and is currently 4-0 overall and 3-0 OAC.

THE COACHES: Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is in his sixth season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including the last seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made trips to the NCAA tournament during Waddle's time at Wittenberg.

Ohio Northern's **Dean Paul** is in his 15th season as the head coach of the Polar Bear football program. Paul, a 1990 graduate of Mount Union, is currently 100-48 at Ohio Northern and 140-60 overall in his career, including five years as head coach at Thomas More College. He notched his 100th win at ONU last week with a 13-7 victory at Otterbein. Paul was a four-year letterman at Mount Union earning All-OAC honors in 1988 and 1990 rushing for over 2,000 yards in his career.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday marks the 45th time that the two teams will meet on the gridiron. **Ohio Northern holds a 33-10-1 lead in the series.** The series began in 1910 with Marietta winning 5-3. The two schools have played every year since 1982. The Pioneers snapped an eight-game ONU winning streak last year with a 35-28 win in Ada.

LAST MEETING: Marietta scored two touchdowns in the final four minutes to come from behind and beat the Polar Bears 35-28 in Dial-Roberson Stadium. All-American running back **Roger Walker** broke a 66-yard TD run with 1:22 left in the game to give MC the deciding points. ONU drove to the Pioneer 7-yard line before turning the ball over on downs with three seconds left on the clock. Walker carried the ball 36 times for 274 yards and four TDs to lead the Marietta attack. ONU quarterback **Will Freed** completed 17-of-32 passes for 245 yards and 3 TDs. **Darrien Fields** completed 11-of-18 passes for 90 yards and 1 TD for MC.

THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 31 letter winners and 17 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 8 starters on offense, 7 on defense and 2 on special teams. The Pioneers are currently ranked 3rd in the OAC in total offense (455.7 ypg) and is 9th in total defense (490.3 ypg). Junior running back **Tanner Clark** is the OAC's leading rusher averaging 173.0 yards on 69 carries. He has 9 rushing and 1 receiving TDs. Senior **Darrien Fields** has completed 51-of-77 passes for 725 yards and 6 TDs. He leads the OAC in completion percentage at 66.2%. Junior wide receiver **Andrew Barker** ranks 3rd in the OAC with 109.0 receiving yards per game and is second with 4 TDs. Senior linebacker **Garrett Davis** is Marietta's leading tackler with 12.0 per game, second best in the OAC.

Ohio Northern returns 36 lettermen and 14 starters off of last year's roster. The Polar Bears return 6 starters on offense, 6 on defense and 2 on special teams. Ohio Northern is ranked 5th in the OAC in total offense (429.5 ypg) and 4th in total defense (334.3 ypg). ONU is led by junior quarterback **Anthony McFadden** who has completed 61-of-99 passes for 789 yards and 8 TDs. He is also averaging 68.8 ypg rushing on 46 carries. The Polar Bears feature a pair of running backs in sophomore **AJ Marks** and freshman **Brock Martin**. Marks averages 88.0 ypg on 41 carries with 2 TDs, while Martin averages 78.0 ypg on 66 carries and is 2nd in the OAC with 7 TDs. Senior wide receiver **Chad Rex** has 307 receiving yards on an OAC-best 29 receptions. He is 3rd in the OAC with 3 TDs. Junior linebacker **Mark Niles** leads the ONU defense and the OAC with 50 tackles

NEXT GAME: The Pioneers hit the road next week for a 1:30 p.m. kickoff at Heidelberg University. Ohio Northern returns home to host John Carroll University for a 1:30 p.m. contest.

THIS WEEK IN THE OAC: All 10 teams are in action this week with 1:30 p.m. start times. Mount Union travels to Otterbein; Wilmington hosts Heidelberg; John Carroll plays at Muskingum; Baldwin Wallace visits Capital and Marietta hosts Ohio Northern.

93RD SEASON OF OAC PLAY: 2018 marks Marietta College's 93rd season of OAC football. The Pioneers, who joined the league in 1926, are 188-371-11 (.339) all-time in OAC play. Marietta's lone OAC championship came in 1936 when the Pioneers went 4-0 in league play.

AERIAL ASSAULT: Senior quarterback **Darrien Fields** is poised to make program history today. With 40 career TD passes, Fields needs one more to tie the program record of 41 held by **Jason Vrable** (2003-06), current assistant coach with the New York Jets. Fields is also 3rd on MC's all-time list for completions with 410 for his career. **Andrew Keller** (2008-11) is 2nd with 484 and Vrable is 1st with 495 career completions. With 4,546 career passing yards, Fields is currently 4th all-time. Vrable holds the MC record with 6,102 career yards, followed by Keller with 5,733 and **Aaron Conte** (1993-96) with 4,820. Fields needs 274 passing yards to catch Conte.

NATIONAL LEADER: Junior running back **Tanner Clark** ranks 2nd in NCAA Division III in several statistical categories including rushing TDs with 9; total TDs with 11, scoring with 22.7 ppg and all-purpose yards with 258.7 ypg. He also ranks 7th in rushing averaging 173.0 ypg.

OAC SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Junior **Tanner Clark** was named the OAC Special Teams Player of the Week after Marietta's 46-20 win at Muskingum. Clark took the opening kickoff of the game back 90-yards for a TD. Clark also had kick returns of 36 and 51 yards in the game. This is Clark's second weekly honor after earning OAC Offensive Player of the Week honors after the Capital victory.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: Junior running back **Tanner Clark** exploded for 311 yards on 34 carries in last week's 51-50 win over Capital in week two. Clark scored 5 rushing TDs and caught 1 pass for a 47-yd TD. His 6 total TDs tied the Marietta single game record held by **Dallas Garber** and All-American **Dante Brown**. His 311 yards rushing is tied for the most in a game this season by any running back in NCAA Division I FCS, FBS, Division II, Division III and NAIA. Marquis Terry from Southeast Missouri State (FCS) rushed for 311 yards against Southern Illinois.

CONTROLLING THE SKIES: The Pioneers intercepted 5 Muskingum passes in the Pioneers' 46-20 victory two weeks ago. That was the most interceptions in a game for Marietta since picking off 5 Otterbein passes in 2011, a 30-27 Pioneer win. Marietta currently leads the OAC with 6 interceptions this season. **Khaleel Danzy** and **Javi Zaragoza** are in a three-way tie for the OAC lead with 2 interceptions apiece.

CAPTAINS ANNOUNCED: Marietta College will have a trio of senior captains during the 2018 season including quarterback **Darrien Fields** (Aliquippa, Pa. / Aliquippa), left tackle **Caleb Riggelman** (Beverly, W.Va. / Elkins) and linebacker **Garrett Davis** (Marietta, Ohio / Marietta).
