THE RECORDS: Saturday marks the sixth week of Ohio Athletic Conference play. Marietta is currently 5-0 overall and 4-0 in the OAC after winning at Heidelberg, 38-34, last week. Wilmington was defeated, 63-7, at #1 Mount Union last week and is currently 1-4 overall and 0-4 in the OAC.

THE COACHES: Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is in his sixth season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made 4 trips to the NCAA playoffs during Waddle's time at Wittenberg.

Wilmington's **Bryan Moore** is in his 2nd season as the head coach of the Quaker football program. Moore, a graduate of Hiram College, came to Wilmington from Bluffton College where he served as the offensive coordinator for three seasons under head coach Denny Dorrel, a former Marietta College assistant. Prior to his time at Bluffton, Moore served as the offensive coordinator at Heidelberg and Emory & Henry. He began his coaching career as an assistant at Thomas More.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday marks the 28th time that the two teams will meet on the gridiron. **Marietta currently leads the series**, **17-10**. The series began in 1915 with the Pioneers winning 68-7. The two schools have played every year since 2000. The Pioneers have won eight of the last 10 meetings and 13 of the 18 games since the series restarted in 2000 after a 45-year hiatus. Marietta has won the last five meetings, with the Quakers' last win coming in 2012 by the score of 13-12 in Wilmington.

LAST MEETING: Marietta jumped out to an early 14-0 lead and never trailed en route to a 43-33 win at Wilmington. Set up by a 52-yard run by All-American running back Roger Walker, left tackle Caleb Riggleman recovered a fumble in the end zone for a TD on Marietta's first possession of the game. Walker finished with 173 yards rushing and 2 TDs on 18 carries. Quarterback Darrien Fields completed 18-of-22 passes for 233 yards and 4 TDs. Wilmington quarterback Luke Creditt completed 28-of-44 passes for 354 yards and 5 TDs. Ameer Jackson had 10 catches for 162 yards. Eric Flynn rushed for 79 yards on 16 carries.

THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 31 letter winners and 17 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 8 starters on offense, 7 on defense and 2 on special teams. The Pioneers are currently ranked 1st in the OAC in total offense (488.4 ypg) and is 9th in total defense (479.8 ypg). Junior running back **Tanner Clark** is the OAC's leading rusher averaging 186.2

yards on 137 carries. He has 14 rushing, 1 receiving and 1 kick return TD. Clark is also tops in the OAC in scoring with 100 points. Senior **Darrien Fields** has completed 95-of-142 passes for 1282 yards and 12 TDs. He leads the OAC in completion percentage at 66.9%. Junior wide receiver **Andrew Barker** ranks 1st in the OAC with 109.8 receiving yards per game and 7 TDs. Senior linebacker **Garrett Davis** is Marietta's leading tackler with 11.0 per game, second best in the OAC.

Wilmington returns 5 starters on offense and 5 on defense. Wilmington is ranked 9th in the OAC in total offense (332.6 ypg) and 8th in total defense (430.4 ypg). Wilmington is led by sophomore quarterback **Kyle Barrett** who has completed 84-of-139 passes for 1104 yards and 9 TDs. He has also been picked off 6 times. Freshman tailback **DJ Chambers** has carried the ball 35 times and averages 45.2 ypg with 2 TDs. Freshmen **Ace Taylor** and **Luke Richardson** are the Quakers' leading receivers. Taylor has 14 catches for 215 yards, while Richardson has 14 catches for 194 yards and 3 TDs. Sophomore safety **Tre'Quez Parks** leads Wilmington with 35 tackles this season.

THIS WEEK IN THE OAC: All 10 teams are in action this week with four 1:30 p.m. starts and one game under the lights at 7 p.m. The early games include Wilmington at Marietta, Capital hosting Mount Union, John Carroll at Ohio Northern and Muskingum at Baldwin Wallace. The late game has Otterbein hosting Heidelberg.

93RD SEASON OF OAC PLAY: 2018 marks Marietta College's 93rd season of OAC football. The Pioneers, who joined the league in 1926, are 190-371-11 (.342) all-time in OAC play. Marietta's lone OAC championship came in 1936 when the Pioneers went 4-0 in league play.

AERIAL ASSAULT: Senior quarterback **Darrien Fields** eclipsed 5,000 career passing yards in Marietta's 38-34 win at Heidelberg last week. Currently, he has 5,062 career yards and is 3rd all-time at Marietta. **Jason Vrable** (2003-06), current assistant coach with the New York Jets, holds the MC record with 6,102 yards followed by **Andrew Keller** (2008-11) with 5,733, Fields and **Aaron Conte** (1993-96) with 4,820. Fields set the MC career record for TD passes two weeks ago and now has 46 for his career. Vrable held the old mark of 41. Fields is also 3rd on MC's all-time list for completions with 454 for his career. Keller is 2nd with 484 and Vrable is 1st with 495 career completions.

NATIONAL LEADER: Junior running back **Tanner Clark** leads Division III in all-purpose yards averaging 263.6 per game. He ranks 3rd in scoring (20.0 ppg), rushing TDs (14) and total TDs (16). Clark is 4th nationally in rushing averaging 186.2 yards per game and is 5th in kickoff returns averaging 36.5 yards per return.

OAC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Junior running back **Tanner Clark** was named the OAC Offensive Player of the Week after Marietta's 38-34 win at Heidelberg last week. It is his second offensive award to go along with one special teams honor. Clark rushed for 232 yards on 34 carries. He scored 3 TDs. Clark also caught a pair of passes for 13 yards and returned two kickoffs for 56 yards finishing the day with 301 all-purpose yards.

OAC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Sophomore defensive lineman **Kyle Gallagher** was named the OAC Defensive Player of the Week after Marietta's 38-34 win at Heidelberg last week. Gallagher led the Pioneers with 10 tackles and had back-to-back sacks that forced Heidelberg to attempt a long field goal that was no good due to a bad snap giving MC the ball for the game-winning drive.

D3FOOTBALL.COM TEAM OF THE WEEK: Marietta's offensive line (Caleb Riggleman-LT, Patrick Taylor-LG, Brendan Mulholland-C, Payton Henderson-RG and Michael Sturgill-RT) earned Team of the Week honors after amassing 544 yards of total offense in the 38-34 win at Heidelberg. The Pioneers lost a total of 3 yards rushing in the game. Marietta leads the OAC in rushing and total offense. Trailing 34-31, Marietta went on a 14-play scoring drive (including 10 running plays) that gave the Pioneers the lead with 1:19 left in the game.

D3FOOTBALL.COM TEAM OF THE WEEK #2: Sophomore defensive lineman **Kyle Gallagher** was named to the Team of the Week after leading the Pioneers with 10 tackles in the 38-34 win at Heidelberg. He had 3.0 tackles for a loss and posted back to back sacks at a crucial point in the game.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: Junior running back Tanner Clark exploded for 311 yards on 34 carries in MC's 51-50 win over Capital. Clark scored 5 rushing TDs and caught 1 pass for a 47-yd TD. His 6 total TDs tied the MC single game record held by **Dallas Garber** and All-American **Dante Brown**. His 311 yards rushing is tied for the 3rd most in a game this season by any running back in NCAA Division I FCS, FBS, Division II, Division III and NAIA. Jaleel McLaughlin from Division II Notre Dame (Ohio) ran for 340 yards against West Liberty. Eno Benjamin from Arizona State (FBS) ran for 312 against Oregon State and Marquis Terry from Southeast Missouri State (FCS) rushed for 311 yards against Southern Illinois.

CONTROLLING THE SKIES: The Pioneers intercepted 5 Muskingum passes in the Pioneers' 46-20 victory four weeks ago. That was the most interceptions in a game for Marietta since picking off 5 Otterbein passes in 2011, a 30-27 Pioneer win. Marietta is currently 2nd in the OAC with 7 interceptions this season. **Khaleel Danzy** and **Javi Zaragoza** are tied for 3rd in the OAC lead with 2 picks apiece.

PERFECT START: The Pioneers have started the season with five straight wins for the first time since the 1923 season. The 1923 team posted victories against Salem, Alderson Broaddus, Marshall, Dayton and Kalamazoo before falling to Grove City. A win against Wilmington would give Marietta it's first 6-0 start since the 1920 season. The 1920 team posted wins against Duquesne, Bethany, Westminster, Michigan State, Grove City and Cincinnati before falling to Boston College. Marietta has never started a season 7-0.

D3FOOTBALL.COM TOP 25: The OAC has two teams in this week's D3football.com Top 25 with #1 Mount Union and #10 John Carroll. Mount received 19 of the 25 first place votes. Baldwin Wallace and Marietta are receiving votes in the poll.

AFCA DIVISION III COACHES TOP 25: The OAC has two teams in this week's AFCA Division III Coaches Top 25 with #1 Mount Union and #13 John Carroll. Mount received 40 of the 52 first place votes. Baldwin Wallace and **Marietta** are receiving votes in the poll.
