**THE RECORDS**: Saturday marks the seventh week of Ohio Athletic Conference play. Marietta is currently 6-0 overall and 5-0 in the OAC after beating Wilmington, 63-321, last week for Homecoming. No. 10 ranked John Carroll defeated Ohio Northern, 49-17, in Ada last week and is currently 5-1 overall and 4-1 in the OAC.

**THE COACHES**: Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is in his sixth season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made 4 trips to the NCAA playoffs during Waddle's time at Wittenberg.

John Carroll's **Rick Finotti** is in his 2nd season as the head coach of the Blue Streak football program. Finotti, a 1995 graduate of Cleveland State University, compiled a 62-15 record as head coach at Lakewood St. Edward High School. He led St. Edward to Ohio Division I state titles in 2010 and 2014. He came to John Carroll after spending two years on Jim Harbaugh's defensive staff at the University of Michigan.

**ALL-TIME SERIES**: Saturday marks the 31st time that the two teams will meet on the gridiron. **John Carroll holds a 29-0-1 lead in the series**. The series began in 1929 with John Carroll winning, 25-6. The lone tie in the series came in 1995 when the Pioneers and Blue Streaks battled to a 21-21 deadlock in Don Drumm Stadium.

**LAST MEETING**: John Carroll led 14-0 after the first quarter and 24-7 at halftime en route to a 48-21 victory in Don Drumm Stadium. All three of Marietta's touchdowns came on **Darrien Fields** passes; two to **Roger Walker** and one to **Tanner Clark**. Fields completed 21-of-29 passes for 206 yards and the 3 touchdowns. The Blue Streaks limited Walker to just 12 yards rushing. JCU quarterback **Anthony Moeglin** completed 17-of-25 passes for 257 yards and 3 TDs. **Ro Golphin** rushed for 103 yards on 15 carries while **Sam Kukura** had 8 carries for 64 yards and 3 TDs. **Jake Tracewell** led the Pioneer defense with 11 tackles, while **Tyshawn Jones** had a team-high 7 tackles for John Carroll.

# THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 31 letter winners and 17 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 8 starters on offense, 7 on defense and 2 on special teams. The Pioneers are currently ranked 2nd in the OAC in total offense (491.2 ypg) and is 9th in total defense (460.7 ypg). Junior running back **Tanner Clark** is the OAC's leading rusher averaging 176.0 yards on 152 carries. He has 16 rushing, 1 receiving and 1 kick return TD. Clark is also tops in the OAC in scoring with 112 points. Senior **Darrien Fields** has completed 114-of-

163 passes for 1490 yards and 17 TDs. He leads the OAC in completion percentage at 69.9%. Junior wide receiver **Andrew Barker** leads Marietta with 439 receiving yards on 19 catches and 7 TDs. Senior linebacker **Garrett Davis** is Marietta's leading tackler with 10.3 per game, second best in the OAC.

John Carroll returns 45 letter winners and 19 starters from last season. The Blue Streaks welcome back 9 starters on offense, 8 on defense and 2 on special teams. John Carroll is ranked 6th in the OAC in total offense (412.5 ypg) and 2nd in total defense (247.8 ypg). John Carroll is led by junior quarterback Anthony Moeglin who has completed 84-of-148 passes for 1086 yards and 10 TDs. Sophomore running back Michael Canganelli is the leading rusher averaging 90.2 ypg and 7 TDs. Senior Sam Kukura averages 50.4 ypg and has 6 TDs. Senior tight end Danny Disbrow is the Blue Streaks' leading receiver with 19 catches for 233 yards and 4 TDs. Junior wide receiver Evan Nugent and Darrin Davis each has 17 receptions. Nugent has 282 yards and 3 TDs, while Davis has 232 yards and 2 TDs. Senior defensive lineman Adam Thompson leads JCU with 33 tackles.

**THIS WEEK IN THE OAC**: All 10 teams are in action this week with four 1:30 p.m. starts and one game kicking off at 2 p.m. The early games include Marietta at John Carroll, Wilmington hosting Baldwin Wallace, Ohio Northern at Capital and Heidelberg at Mount Union. The late game has Muskingum hosting Otterbein.

**93RD SEASON OF OAC PLAY**: 2018 marks Marietta College's 93rd season of OAC football. The Pioneers, who joined the league in 1926, are 191-371-11 (.343) all-time in OAC play. Marietta's lone OAC championship came in 1936 when the Pioneers went 4-0 in league play.

**OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUT**: Through six games this season Marietta has scored 276 points. The 2017 team scored 308 points for the season, which was the most points for the Pioneers in 21 years dating back to the 1996 season when MC scored 355 total points. The Marietta College single season record is 364 points scored in 1995 when the Pioneers finished 8-1-1 overall.

AERIAL ASSAULT: Senior quarterback Darrien Fields eclipsed 5,000 career passing yards in Marietta's 38-34 win at Heidelberg two weeks ago. Currently, he has 5,270 career yards and is 3rd all-time at Marietta. Jason Vrable (2003-06), current assistant coach with the New York Jets, holds the MC record with 6,102 yards followed by Andrew Keller (2008-11) with 5,733, Fields and Aaron Conte (1993-96) with 4,820. Fields set the MC career record for TD passes three weeks ago and now has 51 for his career. Vrable held the old mark of 41. Fields is also 3rd on MC's all-time list for completions with 473 for his career. Keller is 2nd with 484 and Vrable is 1st with 495 career completions.

OAC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Senior quarterback Darrien Fields was named the OAC Offensive Player of the Week after Marietta's 63-21 Homecoming win over Wilmington last week. It is his second weekly offensive award and marked the fourth time this year Marietta claimed the award. Fields was nearly perfect completing 19-of-21 passes for 208 yards and 5 touchdowns. The 5 TDs tied his own school single game record. Fields also averaged 6.6 yards per carry on 5 rushing attempts.

**NATIONAL LEADER:** Junior running back **Tanner Clark** is currently ranked 2nd in Division III all-purpose yards averaging 240.5 per game. He ranks 3rd in rushing yards (1056), scoring (18.7 ppg), rushing TDs (16) and total TDs (18). Clark is 4th nationally

in rushing averaging 176.0 yards per game and kickoff returns averaging 36.5 yards per return.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: Junior running back Tanner Clark exploded for 311 yards on 34 carries in MC's 51-50 win over Capital. Clark scored 5 rushing TDs and caught 1 pass for a 47-yd TD. His 6 total TDs tied the MC single game record held by **Dallas Garber** and All-American **Dante Brown**. His 311 yards rushing is tied for the 4th most in a game this season by any running back in NCAA Division I FCS, FBS, Division II, Division III and NAIA. Connor Silveria from Division II South Dakota School of Mines ran for 425 yards against Adams State last week. Jaleel McLaughlin from Notre Dame (Ohio) (D2) ran for 340 yards against West Liberty. Eno Benjamin from Arizona State (FBS) ran for 312 against Oregon State and Marquis Terry from Southeast Missouri State (FCS) rushed for 311 yards against Southern Illinois.

**CONTROLLING THE SKIES**: The Pioneers intercepted 5 Muskingum passes in the Pioneers' 46-20 victory earlier this season. That was the most interceptions in a game for Marietta since picking off 5 Otterbein passes in 2011, a 30-27 Pioneer win. Marietta is currently 2nd in the OAC with 8 interceptions this season. **Javi Zaragoza** is in a three-way tie for the OAC lead in interceptions with 3 picks this fall.

**PERFECT START**: The Pioneers have started the season with six straight wins for the first time since the 1920 season. The 1920 team posted wins against Duquesne, Bethany, Westminster, Michigan State, Grove City and Cincinnati before falling to Boston College. Marietta has never started a season 7-0.

**D3FOOTBALL.COM TOP 25**: The OAC has two teams in this week's D3football.com Top 25 with #1 Mount Union and #10 John Carroll. Mount received 19 of the 25 first place votes. Baldwin Wallace and **Marietta** are receiving votes in the poll.

**AFCA DIVISION III COACHES TOP 25**: The OAC has two teams in this week's AFCA Division III Coaches Top 25 with #1 Mount Union and #13 John Carroll. Mount received 41 of the 52 first place votes. Baldwin Wallace and **Marietta** are receiving votes in the poll.
