THE RECORDS: Saturday marks the ninth week of Ohio Athletic Conference play. Marietta is currently 6-2 overall and 5-2 in the OAC after dropping a heartbreaker to Baldwin Wallace, 30-28, on a last second field goal in Don Drumm Stadium last week. Otterbein lost to crosstown rival Capital by the score of 23-19 at home last week and is 1-7 overall and 0-7 in the OAC.

THE COACHES: Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is in his sixth season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made 4 trips to the NCAA playoffs during Waddle's time at Wittenberg.

Otterbein's **Tim Doup** is in his seventh season as the head coach of the Cardinal football program. Doup, a 1992 graduate of Otterbein, is currently 34-34 in his coaching career at Otterbein. Doup spent nine seasons as the offensive coordinator with the Cardinals before taking over as head coach in 2012. Doup was a four-year letter winner at center for the Cardinals and served as team captain his senior season.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday marks the 91st time that Marietta and Otterbein will meet on the gridiron. **Otterbein holds a 48-42 lead in the series**. The series began in 1892 with the Pioneers winning 6-0. The two schools have played every year since 1950. The Cardinals have won eight of the last 10 meetings, including the last six in a row. Marietta's last win came in 2011 by the score of 30-27.

LAST MEETING: Otterbein raced out to a 34-0 halftime lead en route to the 48-14 victory in Don Drumm Stadium. Cardinal quarterback **Logan Stepp** accounted for five touchdowns as he rushed for 135 yards and 2 TDs and completed 17-of-24 passes for 203 yards and 3 TDs. **Dakota Smith** had 17 carries for 98 yards and 1 TD, while **Hunter Joseph** had 8 catches for 105 yards and 2 TDs. **Roger Walker** scored both Marietta TDs. He had 30 carries for 214 yards and 1 TD and caught 5 passes for 75 yards and 1 TD. **Darrien Fields** completed 14-of-23 passes for 90 yards and 1 TD.

THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 31 letter winners and 17 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 8 starters on offense, 7 on defense and 2 on special teams. The Pioneers are currently ranked 2nd in the OAC in total offense (462.5 ypg) and is 8th in total defense (447.4 ypg). Junior running back **Tanner Clark** is the OAC's leading rusher averaging 164.4 yards on 205 carries. He has 18 rushing, 2 receiving and 2 kickoff return TDs. Clark

is also tops in the OAC in scoring with 136 points. Senior **Darrien Fields** has completed 156-of-232 passes for 1973 yards and 19 TDs. He is second in the OAC in completion percentage at 67.2% and TDs. Junior wide receiver **Andrew Barker** leads Marietta with 506 receiving yards on 23 catches and 7 TDs. Sophomore wide receiver **Maguire Morris** leads the team with 40 catches for 411 yards and 2 TDs Senior linebacker **Garrett Davis** is Marietta's leading tackler with 9.0 per game, eighth best in the OAC.

Otterbein returns 42 letter winners and 10 starters from last season. The Cardinals welcome back 4 starters on offense and 6 on defense. Otterbein is ranked 10th in the OAC in total offense (219.4 ypg) and 4th in total defense (343.3 ypg). Otterbein is led by senior quarterback Steven Irwin who has completed 72-of-151 passes for 750 yards and 4 TDs. Senior running back Dakota Smith is the leading rusher averaging 54.7 ypg with 2 TDs. Senior wide receiver Payton Vanderkooi is the Cardinals' leading receiver with 22 catches for 312 yards and 2 TDs. Junior linebacker Ryan Tuchow and sophomore defensive back Niall Lewison lead the Otterbein defense. Tuchow has a team-high 74 tackles, while Lewison has 66 tackles.

THIS WEEK IN THE OAC: All 10 teams are in action this week with 1:30 p.m. starts. In addition to Marietta at Otterbein, Ohio Northern plays at Baldwin Wallace, Capital hosts Wilmington, Heidelberg travels to John Carroll and Muskingum hosts Mount Union.

93RD SEASON OF OAC PLAY: 2018 marks Marietta College's 93rd season of OAC football. The Pioneers, who joined the league in 1926, are 191-373-11 (.342) all-time in OAC play. Marietta's lone OAC championship came in 1936 when the Pioneers went 4-0 in league play.

OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUT: Through eight games this season Marietta has scored 328 points. The 2017 team scored 308 points for the season, which was the most points for the Pioneers in 21 years dating back to the 1996 season when MC scored 355 total points. The Marietta College single season record is 364 points scored in 1995 when the Pioneers finished 8-1-1 overall.

AERIAL ASSAULT: Senior quarterback **Darrien Fields** set the Marietta all-time record for pass completions with 515 career completions last week against Baldwin Wallace. The old mark of 495 was held by **Jason Vrable** (2003-06), current assistant coach with the New York Jets. Fields set the MC career record for TD passes several weeks ago and now has 53 for his career. Vrable held the old mark of 41. Fields is also on pace to set the school record for career passing yards. Vrable holds the record with 6,102 yards followed by Fields with 5,753 and **Andrew Keller** (2008-11) with 5,733. Fields needs 349 yards to pass Vrable for first place.

NATIONAL LEADER: Junior running back **Tanner Clark** is currently ranked 1st in Division III all-purpose yards averaging 237.6 per game, kickoff returns averaging 40.8 yards per return and kickoff return touchdowns with 2. He ranks 3rd in scoring (17.0 ppg), rushing TDs (18) and total TDs (22). Clark is 4th nationally in total rushing yards (1315) and 5th nationally in rushing averaging 164.4 yards per game.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: Junior running back **Tanner Clark** exploded for 311 yards on 34 carries in MC's 51-50 win over Capital. Clark scored 5 rushing TDs and caught 1 pass for a 47-yd TD. His 6 total TDs tied the MC single game record held by **Dallas Garber** and All-American **Dante Brown**. His 311 yards rushing is tied for the 9th most in a game

this season by any running back in NCAA Division I FCS, FBS, Division II, Division III and NAIA. Connor Silveria from Division II South Dakota School of Mines ran for 425 yards against Adams State. Aaron Dawson from Central Connecticut State (FCS) ran for 361 yards against Wagner. Jaleel McLaughlin from Notre Dame (Ohio) (D2) ran for 340 yards against West Liberty. Walter Fletcher from Edinboro (D2) ran for 328 yards against Seton Hill. Gabe Watson from Sioux Falls (D2) ran for 320 against MSU Moorhead. Jordan Meachum from Sacred Heart (FCS) ran for 318 yards against Bryant. Demarco Prewitt from Kansas Wesleyan (NAIA) ran for 314 yards against Bethel. Eno Benjamin from Arizona State (FBS) ran for 312 against Oregon State and Marquis Terry from Southeast Missouri State (FCS) rushed for 311 yards against Southern Illinois.

CONTROLLING THE SKIES: The Pioneers intercepted 5 Muskingum passes in the Pioneers' 46-20 victory earlier this season. That was the most interceptions in a game for Marietta since picking off 5 Otterbein passes in 2011, a 30-27 Pioneer win. Marietta is currently tied for 1st in the OAC with John Carroll with 11 interceptions this season. **Javi Zaragoza** is tied for the conference lead with 4 picks this fall.

IT'S GOOD: Senior kicker **Jimmy Embrescia** converted all four of his PAT attempts last week against Baldwin Wallace giving him a school-record 40 PATs for the season. The old Pioneer record was 39 and was set by Darrell Shuss in 1996. For the season, Embrescia has accounted for 52 points, ranking ninth in the OAC in scoring.

ADDITIONAL RECORDS TO WATCH: The Pioneers are on track to set several other single season records. **Tanner Clark** needs 5 TDs to tie the school record of 27 set by **Dante Brown** in 1996. He is also 30 points away from equaling Brown's school record of 166 points set in 1996. **Darrien Fields** needs 2 passing TDs to tie his own school record of 21 set last fall. **Andrew Barker** is 1 TD recpetion from tying the school record of 8 set by **Antonio Hutton** in 1996 and tied by **Jason Curry** in 2006.

PERFECT START: The Pioneers started the season with six straight wins for the first time since the 1920 season. The 1920 team posted wins against Duquesne, Bethany, Westminster, Michigan State, Grove City and Cincinnati before falling to Boston College.

D3FOOTBALL.COM TOP 25: The OAC has two teams in this week's D3football.com Top 25 with #1 Mount Union and #9 John Carroll. Mount received 20 of the 25 first place votes. Baldwin Wallace is receiving votes in the poll.

AFCA DIVISION III COACHES TOP 25: The OAC has three teams in this week's AFCA Division III Coaches Top 25 with #1 Mount Union, #10 John Carroll and #24 Baldwin Wallace. Mount received 41 of the 52 first place votes.
