THE RECORDS: Saturday marks the 2019 season opener for both teams. Marietta finished the 2018 campaign with a 7-3 overall record and went 6-3 in the rugged Ohio Athletic Conference. It was the Pioneers' best season since going 7-3 in 1996. Hiram posted a 2-8 overall mark last fall and finished 1-8 in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

THE COACHES: Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is in his seventh season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including the last seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made four trips to the NCAA tournament during Waddle's time at Wittenberg. Waddle was named the OAC Coach of the Year in 2017 after leading the Pioneers' to their first winning season since 2006. Waddle's career record is 21-39 in his six seasons as Marietta's head coach.

Hiram's **Henry Stanford** is in his fourth season as the head coach of the Terrier football program. Stanford, a 1998 graduate of Ohio State University, is currently 7-23 at Hiram and 19-41 overall in his head coaching career. Stanford was an assistant coach at Hiram for three years before taking over as head coach. He came to Hiram from Capital University where he served three seasons as head coach. Prior to Capital, Stanford was an assistant coach at Elmhurst, Tiffin, Kenyon, Otterbein and Ohio State.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday marks the 33rd time that Marietta and Hiram will meet on the gridiron. **Marietta holds a 26-5-1 lead in the series.** The first meeting took place in 1914 with Marietta winning 82-0. The two schools have faced each other annually since from 1989-99 with the Pioneers winning 10 of those 11 games. Hiram's last victory over Marietta was a 35-29 win in 1991. The Pioneers have won the last eight meetings including the most recent, a 38-14 win in 1999.

LAST MEETING: October 30, 1999 at Hiram. Marietta jumped out to an early lead and never looked back. The Pioneers led 24-0 at halftime and went on to win, 38-14. Pioneer running back **Kenneth Sasu** scored four rushing touchdowns and finished with 242 yards rushing on 39 carries. Quarterback **Shawn Taylor** threw for 64 yards including a 23-yard touchdown pass to **Jay Gerber**.

THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 32 letter winners and 11 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 6 starters on offense, 4 on defense and 1 on special teams. Marietta averaged 37.8 points, 180.2 yards rushing, 268.2 yards passing and 448.4 total yards per game in 2018. The Pioneers allowed their opponents 31.8 points, 177.7 yards rushing, 253.6 yards passing and 431.3 total yards per game. All-American running back **Tanner Clark** returns for his senior season after leading the OAC with 144.6 rushing yards per game. He was also tops in the conference in scoring with 141 total points scored. The Pioneers return their top seven receivers from last fall including seniors **Andrew Barker** and **Ryan VanMeter**. Barker caught 23 passes for 506 yards and 7 touchdowns, while VanMeter had 33 catches for 407 yards and 5 TDs. Junior **Maguire Morris** was MC's leading receiver a year ago with 50 catches for 578 yards and 2 TDs. Marietta returns a pair of defensive backs. Senior **James Knox** and junior **Tay Pryor** will anchor the Pioneer defense. Pryor had 34 tackles and 3 interceptions last year, while Knox finished with 30 tackles and 3 interceptions.

Hiram returns 31 lettermen and 17 starters off of last year's roster. The Terriers return 7 starters on offense, 7 on defense and 3 on special teams. Hiram averaged 24.4 points, 141.8 yards rushing, 194.4 yards passing and 336.2 total yards per game in 2018. The Terriers allowed their opponents 38.5 points, 185.4 yards rushing, 232.5 yards passing and 417.9 total yards per game. Hiram returns four starters on the offensive line and a trio of wide receivers. Senior **Jaris Foreman** caught 36 passes for 496 yards and 3 touchdowns. Junior **Tahj Lorthridge** had 32 catches for 335 yards and 6 TDs, while junior **Moe Yarbrough** had 27 catches for 260 yards and 2 TDs. Senior linebacker **Horace Johnson** led the Terriers with 83 total tackles, including 4.0 sacks, last fall.

CAPTAINS ANNOUNCED: The Pioneers will have five captains for the 2019 season including seniors defensive back **James Knox** (Charleston, W.Va. / Capital), running back **Tanner Clark** (Caldwell, Ohio / Caldwell), quarterback **Kyle McSweeney** (Independence, Ohio / Trinity) and wide receiver **Ryan VanMeter** (Maysville, W.Va. / Petersburg) and junior defensive lineman **Kyle Gallagher** (Chesterland, Ohio / West Geauga).

THIS WEEK IN THE OAC: All 10 OAC schools open their seasons this week. Capital already kicked off the new season with a 66-7 loss at Westminster on Thursday. The other nine schools open Saturday. Baldwin Wallace travels to Alma and John Carroll hosts Wisconsin-Stevens Point in 1 p.m. kickoffs. At 1:30 p.m. Waynesburg plays at Muskingum, while Otterbein heads to Ohio Wesleyan for a 2 p.m. start. Adrian hosts Heidelberg at 6 p.m., while the 7 p.m. kickoffs include Marietta at Hiram, Mount Union at Rose-Hulman, Ohio Northern at Denison and Olivet at Wilmington.

94TH SEASON OF OAC PLAY: 2019 marks Marietta College's 94th season of OAC football. The Pioneers, who joined the league in 1926, are 192-374-11 (.342) all-time in OAC play. Marietta's lone OAC championship came in 1936 when the Pioneers went 4-0 in league play.

HOME OPENER: Marietta's home opener is set for September 21st when rival Muskingum University visits Don Drumm Stadium for a 7 p.m. kickoff. The Shrine Trophy will be on the line as Marietta looks to retain the hardware for a third straight year. There will be a free pregame concert featuring the band Aftershock and a fireworks display following the game.
