THE RECORDS: Saturday marks the first week of Ohio Athletic Conference play. Marietta is currently 1-0 overall after knocking off Hiram on the road, 41-0, last week. Capital lost its season opener on the road at Westminster last week by the score of 66-7.

THE COACHES: Marietta's Andy Waddle is in his seventh season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including the last seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made four trips to the NCAA tournament during Waddle's time at Wittenberg. Waddle was named the OAC Coach of the Year in 2017 after leading the Pioneers' to their first winning season since 2006. Waddle's career record is 22-39 in his six-plus seasons as Marietta's head coach.

Capital's **Chad Rogosheske** is in his fourth season as the head coach of the Crusader football program. Rogosheske, a 1998 graduate of Hamline University, is currently 18-43 in his coaching career having gone 10-20 in three years at the helm of Hamline and is 8-23 at Capital. Rogosheske spent time as an assistant at Bucknell, Hamline, Wartburg and Ohio State.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday marks the 89th time that Marietta and Capital will meet on the gridiron. Capital holds a 55-31-2 lead in the series. The first meeting took place in 1927 with Marietta winning 14-0. The two schools have faced each other annually since 1946. The Pioneers dominated the series early on winning seven of the first 10 meetings. In recent years, Capital has controlled the series winning 15 in a row prior to Marietta's current streak of three consecutive wins, including a thrilling 51-50 win in Don Drumm last year.

point conversion with 26 seconds left in the game to preserve the 51-50 victory for the Navy Blue and White. The Crusaders jumped out to an early 14-0 lead and stayed in front until **Tanner Clark** scored from 5-yards out early in the fourth quarter to give Marietta a 43-37 lead. Clark finished with 311 yards rushing, 5 rushing TDs and 1 TD reception in the game. Wibbeler completed 33-of-53 passes for 511 yards and 5 TDs. He also rushed for 85 yards and 1 TD. **David Barnett** caught 12 of Wibbeler's passes for 225 yards and 1 TD. **Darrien Fields** completed 14-of-22 passes for 214 yards and 2 TDs for the Pioneers.

THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 32 letter winners and 11 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 6 starters on offense, 4 on defense and 1 on special teams. Marietta is currently ranked 4th in the OAC in total offense (435.0 ypg), 5th in passing offense (240.0 ypg) and 4th in rushing offense (195.0 ypg). The Pioneers are ranked 1st in total defense (168.0 ypg), 2nd in passing defense (66.0 ypg) and 4th in rushing defense (102.0 ypg). All-American running back **Tanner Clark** is 2nd in the OAC averaging 116.0 ypg rushing. Senior quarterback **Kyle McSweeney** is 5th in the OAC with 217.0 ypg passing and is 3rd with 4 TD passes. Senior wide receiver **Andrew Barker** is 9th with 60.0 ypg receiving and tied for 2nd with 3 TD receptions.

Capital returns 55 lettermen and 14 starters off of last year's roster. The Crusaders return 5 starters on offense, 6 on defense and 3 on special teams. Capital is currently ranked 8th in the OAC in total offense (290.0 ypg), 8th in passing offense (128.0 ypg) and 6th in rushing offense (162.0 ypg). The Crusaders are ranked 9th in total defense (316.0 ypg), 8th in passing defense (173.0 ypg) and 7th in rushing defense (143.0 ypg). Senior running back Evin Butler leads the Capital ground attack averaging 95.0 ypg. The Crusaders played three different quarterbacks in their season opener. Junior **Andrew Ray** got the start and completed 8-of-16 passes for 50 yards. He was picked off 3 times. Junior Mitchell Machock completed 5-of-11 passes for 62 yards with 1 TD and 1 interception. Freshman **Justin** McClelland completed 4-of-8 passes for 16 yards and 1 interception. Eight different players caught passes in the opener. Junior running back **Dylan Schoonover** had 3 catches for 28 yards and 1 TD. Senior wide receiver **David Barnett** caught 3 passes for 26 yards and sophomore tight end Kameron Lee had 3 catches for 22 yards.

CAPTAINS ANNOUNCED: The Pioneers will have five captains for the 2019 season including seniors defensive back **James Knox** (Charleston, W.Va. / Capital), running back **Tanner Clark** (Caldwell, Ohio / Caldwell),
