SHRINE TROPHY GAME: Marietta and Muskingum will battle tonight in the annual Shrine Trophy Game. The trophy is sponsored by the two school's local Shrine Clubs. The Pioneers are looking to retain possession of the trophy for a third straight year after beating Muskingum the last two seasons. The Muskies hold a 7-3 edge since the Shrine Trophy Game started in 2009.

THE RECORDS: Saturday marks the second week of Ohio Athletic Conference play. Marietta is currently 2-0 overall and 1-0 in the OAC after knocking off Capital on the road, 44-7, last week. Muskingum is 1-1 overall (0-1) after falling at home to Ohio Northern, 39-10, last week.

THE COACHES: Marietta's **Andy Waddle** is in his seventh season at the helm of the Pioneer program. He is the 29th head coach in program history. Waddle, a 2003 graduate of Wittenberg University, spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, including the last seven as the defensive coordinator prior to coming to Marietta. The Tigers won four North Coast Athletic Conference championships and made four trips to the NCAA tournament during Waddle's time at Wittenberg. Waddle was named the OAC Coach of the Year in 2017 after leading the Pioneers' to their first winning season since 2006. Waddle's career record is 23-39 in his six-plus seasons as Marietta's head coach.

Muskingum's **Erik leuter** is in his second season as the head coach of the Muskie football program. leuter, a 2003 graduate of Albion College, came to Muskingum after serving as an assistant at the University of Florida for a year. His career record stands at 5-7. Prior to that he spent 11 years as an assistant at NCAA Division II Michigan Tech. leuter played collegiately at Albion where he was a wide receiver and helped the Britons win a pair of Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association championships.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Saturday marks the 98th time that the two teams will meet on the gridiron. **Muskingum holds a 52-43-2 lead in the series**. The series began in 1897 with the Pioneers winning 36-0. The two schools have played every year since 1968. Muskingum has won seven of the last 10 meetings. However, the Pioneers have won three of the last four, including last year's 46-20 win in New Concord and a 49-25 win in Marietta in 2017.

LAST MEETING: September 15, 2018 at Muskingum. Pioneer special teams provided the perfect bookends to Marietta's 46-20 win in New Concord. **Tanner Clark** returned the opening kick-off 90 yards for a touchdown and then **Tay**

Pryor returned an interception 38-yards for a touchdown in the final minutes of the game. **Darrien Fields** completed 22-of-34 passes for 311 yards and 3 touchdowns. **Maguire Morris** had 9 catches for 93 yards and **Andrew Barker** had 5 catches for 134 yards and 2 touchdowns. Clark rushed for 80 yards and 1 TD. **Marvis Hood** ran for a pair of TDs for the Muskies.

THE TEAMS:

Marietta returns 32 letter winners and 11 starters from last season. The Pioneers welcome back 6 starters on offense, 4 on defense and 1 on special teams. Marietta is currently ranked 4th in the OAC in total offense (388.5 ypg), 6th in passing offense (202.0 ypg) and 4th in rushing offense (186.5 ypg). The Pioneers are ranked 1st in total defense (199.0 ypg), 2nd in passing defense (134.5.0 ypg) and 2nd in rushing defense (64.5 ypg). All-American running back Tanner Clark is 3rd in the OAC averaging 111.5 ypg rushing and is tied for 1st with 3 rushing TDs. Senior quarterback Kyle McSweeney is 6th in the OAC with 190.5 ypg passing and is tied for 1st with 7 TD passes. Senior wide receiver Andrew Barker is 9th averaging 58.0 ypg receiving and is tied for 1st with 5 TD receptions. Junior defensive back Tay Pryor leads the Pioneer defense with 14 total tackles.

Muskingum returns 25 lettermen and 15 starters off of last year's roster. The Muskies return 4 starters on offense, 9 on defense and 2 on special teams. Muskingum is currently ranked 7th in the OAC in total offense (305.5 ypg), 9th in passing offense (150.0 ypg) and 5th in rushing offense (155.5 ypg). The Muskies are ranked 7th in total defense (325.0 ypg), 8th in passing defense (191.0 ypg) and 5th in rushing defense (134.0 ypg). Dual threat junior quarterback **Brody Hahn** leads the Muskie offense. He has completed 22-of-39 passes for 114.5 ypg and 1 TD. Hahn is also averaging 56.5 ypg rushing and has 3 rushing TDs. Senior running back **Bernard Johnson**, a Marietta High School graduate, averages 58.5 ypg rushing. Hahn's top target is freshman wide receiver **Tyler Heinecke** who averages 43.5 ypg receiving. Defensively, Muskingum is led by junior linebacker **Nehemiah Bowie** and senior defensive end **Tim Ousley**. Bowie leads the team with 19 total tackles, while Ousley leads the OAC with 4.0 tackles for a loss and 2.5 sacks.

OAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Sophomore punter Bailey Sprague was named the OAC Special Teams Player of the Week after averaging 33.7 yards per punt in Marietta's 44-7 win at Capital. Sprague kept Marietta on the positive side of the field position battle placing a pair of punts inside the Capital 20-yard line and forcing 3 fair catches. The 2 punts Capital tried to return resulted in -10 return yards giving Sprague a 35.1 ypp net punting average.

SENIORS HONORING CLASSMATE JOEL WUNNENBERG: The six seniors on this year's team will alternate wearing jersey #38 to honor Joel Wunnenberg, a classmate who passed away unexpectedly in March of 2017. Wunnenberg was a linebacker and running back from Springdale, Pa. He was majoring in Petroleum Engineering at Marietta College. TJ West wore the #38 jersey in the season-opener at Hiram. The other five members of the senior class will wear the special number in the five home games. All-American Tanner Clark has the honor this week against Muskingum. Quarterback Kyle McSweeney will wear it against Heidelberg, followed by wide receiver Andrew Barker against John Carroll, defensive back James Knox against Otterbein and wide receiver Ryan VanMeter in
